JANUARY 29-30, February 5-6, 2022

1. Every entrant must be a USBC member as of JANUARY 1, 2022.
2. Doubles consist of one man and one woman, two women, or two men per team.
3. ATTIRE: Members are required to wear suitable attire. NO SHORT SHORTS OR HALTER TOPS WILL BE ALLOWED. This will be at the Tournament Chairperson's discretion and any bowler may be asked to change attire before bowling.
4. Entrants shall use their highest USBC sanctioned league average as of the seasons (2019/2020) OR (2020/2021) provided they have bowled 21 games or more. If the entrant has no winter season average in their local association, they shall use their highest 2021 USBC summer average. If a bowler has no league average from one of those, they shall use January 1, 2022, average provided they have bowled 21 games. All USBC rules for 2021/22 shall govern play during tournament. The 10-pin rule is in effect.
5. ALL BOWLERS MUST CHECK IN WITH THE TOURNAMENT OFFICE 30 MINUTES PRIOR TO BOWLING TIME.
6. **ENTRIES MUST BE RECEIVED NO LATER THAN JANUARY 25, 2022. ANY ENTRIES RECEIVED AFTER THE DEADLINE WILL BE RETURNED. *******
7. Handicap shall be 90% of the difference between bowler's average & 230. Bowlers must enter Handicap events in order to bowl Scratch events.
8. A bowler who enters the Doubles event must also enter the Singles event & vice versa. Singles will be bowled first and bowlers will not change lanes for Singles and Doubles event.
9. **There will be an Open Division and a Women's Division in all of the events.**
10. A bowler may bowl more than once in Singles & Doubles but can only cash once in the Singles event. In the Doubles event a bowler can only cash once with the same partner.
11. Substitutes are allowed. No rearranging of partners will be permitted.
12. Bowlers arriving late may bowl. Frames missed will be zero. The score will start with the frame in which the bowler is ready to bowl. No blind score is allowed for missed frames.
13. Any protest affecting eligibility or playing rules must be confirmed in writing to the tournament manager within 72 hours. Rulings from tournament manager will be given within seven calendar days of protest being received.
14. NO FOOD OR BEVERAGE WILL BE PERMITTED IN THE BOWLING AREA.
15. Only bowlers and tournament officials will be permitted in the bowling area. (NO FRIENDS, FAMILY, CHILDREN OR SPECTATORS ALLOWED IN BOWLING AREA.)
16. The overhead monitors will be used as the official scores. Each bowler is responsible for the accuracy of their score. If an error should occur on the monitor, a Tournament Official shall be contacted to make any changes in the overhead monitors. Game scores should be transferred from the overhead monitors to printed recap sheets.
17. There is to be TEN minutes practice on your assigned lanes the day of the tournament. Lane assignments will be made by Tournament Manager.
18. The Tournament Manager and co-managers shall decide any questions not covered above.
19. All six games bowled the same shift.
